THE ADVENT WREATH - Advent wreaths are circular, representing God's infinite love and are made of evergreen leaves, which represent the hope of eternal life brought by Jesus Christ. Within the Advent wreath are candles that represent the four weeks of the Advent season as well as the light of God coming into the world through the birth of Jesus Christ. In our tradition the candles specifically symbolize HOPE (week one), PEACE (week two), JOY (week three) and LOVE (week four). The white candle in the centre, known as the "Christ Candle," symbolizes the arrival of Jesus and is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day.
