LETTER FROM THE GEISTERFERS - Dear friends: We request your prayers for Caspar, who will travel to Michigan in early September to undergo tests that cannot be done here in Honduras. A CT scan done here identified issues with his lungs, similar to something he experienced in 2016. Last time, further testing did not reveal cancer, and we pray this round of tests will be the same, recognizing that he is God's hands.

At the end of August, Leanne will be facilitating a trauma healing group with staff and collaborators of the Nehemiah Center in Nicaragua. During July, the government used forceful means to quell protests across the country, including areas where some partner organizations are active. Pray with us for true peace, with justice, in Nicaragua. And pray that Leanne's time there will be a time of deep healing, especially for the staff who are in the process of developing a reconciliation and peace-building program they hope can be carried out on a very broad level in the coming year.

Leanne will be taking a three-month sabbatical leave from September to December and shares the goals for that in the attached letter. If you have any questions during that time, please be sure to connect with Caspar. Thank you for your continued prayers and support!
