

Greetings from Honduras!

It seems we're racing forward in the new year. In this update, we share about World Renew's response to flooding in Honduras and local churches with open doors, who minister to those around them. Please check it out.

Since writing this update, the political situation in Haiti has continued to deteriorate. There is unrest in the streets that has made it difficult for staff to get to the office or program sites; electricity and clean water are scarce; and food supplies are getting limited. Two Resonate families with small children have temporarily left for the US. Please pray for the remaining members of the team, and all the staff of our partner churches and organizations, so they are kept safe.

We trust the promise that our prayers are heard.
