World Renew Disaster Response Services (DRS) - In response to the flooding in Eastern Canada this season, World Renew is in daily contact with the NGO Alliance of Ontario and has engaged with our partner, Samaritan's Purse Canada (SPC), who have a Disaster Response Unit in Ottawa. SPC is coordinating work for World Renew DRS volunteers to help with clean-up efforts, the first step after a flood. Christian Reformed congregations in Eastern Ontario have been contacted about this service opportunity. After this initial recovery phase, we will assess with the local community if there is a need for other World Renew DRS services.
