On Wednesday, I went to the hospital after work and held him for over 1.5 hours... such a beautiful experience! He is now almost 7 lbs and will be 5 months old on August 2 and has outgrown the preemie outfits he had! Thank you so very much for your continued prayers and words of support - they hold us up
