COMMUNAL GATHERING: On Sept 22, at 7 p.m. (after 'coffee' at 6:45), West End CRC together with the Classis Alberta North sub-committee formed to look at matters of sexuality, is hosting an evening of information and discussion with Dr. Jeffrey Weima. The evening will include a brief overview of the sub-committees work and goals along with an introduction to the context in which these discussions come; an address by Dr. Weima on "Same-Sex Sex: What Does the New Testament Say?" and round table discussion asking what we are hearing and understanding, and what do we need in looking ahead. Dr. Weima is Professor of New Testament at Calvin Theological Seminary and Co-chair of the synodical committee on "A Biblical Theology of Human Sexuality". Delight in Creation

Our DELIGHT program begins in 2 weeks!

Each regular Sunday includes:

- ~30 minutes with our small age-level group + mentor + runner:
 - a) introductions around a particular theme and a story by the special guest,
 - b) class response, which may include creating a card or picture to be given to the special guest following the service.
- ~15 minutes of gathering time. This includes singing, memory verse recitation, reflections on individual class experiences, and ongoing lessons surrounding creation.

Special CREATE classes, approximately every 4th week, will involve children in creating a responsive act of gratitude in the form of song, drama, or art. These activities will include K-3 and be cross-age groupings (the two youngest classes will continue their regular routine). We will need a **teacher/guide** for each of these three CREATE activities, approximately once every 4th Sunday.

MEMORY CLUB provides the opportunity for children and **everyone else** in our church family to memorize and recite specific scripture verses and/or passages. These verses and passages will be provided at the beginning of each Creation theme. We are seeking **two volunteers** to hear and log successful recitations of these memorized passages, informally before or after the worship services. These volunteers can be any diligent and organized person age 10-90.

We need a few more **mentors**, and many **special guests** throughout the year for story-telling!

We are also looking for a volunteer for each of the following:

- 1. supplies coordinator
- 2. PR coordinator for posters, announcements, etc.
- 3. registration and attendance coordinator

We covet your prayers and your extra effort in getting to know these children by name and perhaps by interest. Connecting warmly with a child can have a profound and long-lasting effect for both adult and child.
