#### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS FROM NOVEMBER MEETINGS:

The council meeting was opened with devotions and prayer bowl, where we select names from the congregations to pray for.

Our Finance Coordinator Jen F joined the session and presented the upcoming Church budget for review by Council. This was followed up with a discussion about the possibility of hiring a part-time second pastor to serve at Ebenezer. This idea is in the beginning stages and we look forward to discussing this topic at the upcoming congregational meeting and getting feedback from the congregation.

Council has been looking at all the youth programs in the Church and noticed an absence of programs for young adults aged 18 and over. Building on the good work done by many to support our youth, this is a topic of continuing interest to Council, and will be followed up with more discussions. The Classis Alberta North Youth Advisor will also be coming to present to Council in the new year.

The Ebenezer Council also met with the Rimbey and Ponoka CRC Councils this month. This session aligns with work by Classis Alberta North to support Church Visitation among neighbouring Church Councils. It also provided a great opportunity to support and learn from each other as we discussed different challenges and encouraging developments in our Churches.

Through different avenues of discussion, one of the main items reviewed was the importance of engaging youth in the Church. Our neighbouring Councils will continue to explore this opportunity area.
