Full of practical insights, Comer focuses on four areas where we can cultivate slowness as a spiritual discipline: Seeking silence, observing the Sabbath, cultivating simplicity, and practicing slowness.

Adorning the Darkness by Andrew Peterson. Andrew is a singer/songwriter and novelist. This book is all about the intersection between art, community and Christianity. Highly recommended for those who are interested in those topics.
