In the next 2 seconds someone will be forced out of their home.

Here are just a few statistics to help you understand the breadth of the refugee experience:

- 79.5 million people around the world have been forcibly displaced.
 26 million of these people are refugees.
 45.7 million remain in their own country, but have lost their homes. 4.2 million are seeking asylum, living in uncertainty while they wait for refugee status.
- Developing countries host more than 80% of the world's refugees.

- 1.4 million vulnerable refugees urgently need resettlement. Less than 5% were resettled.
- Resettlement is a lifesaving measure for those at risk and in need of protection.
