

Deacon's Corner

1st Offering — EBENEZER MINISTRIES This offering is used to cover day-to-day expenses of the church, fund the various ministries at Ebenezer, cover the salaries of staff, and contributes to the ministry shares that we are committed to as members of CRC Denomination.

2nd Offering — **CRC MINISTRY TO SEAFARERS** This ministry exists to be a seafarer's advocate and first line of support, to lend a sympathetic ear and a helping hand when those serving on ships reach the ports in Delta and Vancouver. This ministry can assist in providing a safe and relaxing place that all seafarers can call their home-away from-home. Rev. Gary Roosma is serving as the Chaplain in the Port of Vancouver. Also In 2020 over 1300 gifts were distributed to 68 ships over a period of about 1 month and gifts were delivered on Christmas Eve to ships anchored in the Vancouver harbours.

NEXT WEEK 2nd Offering — **NOW, NEIGHBOURS OUTREACH WETASKIWIN** is a group of Christians from various churches that provides a bag lunch DAILY to the people staying in tents behind Walmart as well as to about 60 community people. Mustard seed is going to take over the care of tent city, but they are not providing food.
