Council Highlights-May 3

Roy V opened by reading Jeremiah 20, which describes Jeremiah being beaten for prophesying and complaining about the treatment he receives for speaking God's word. In the same passage, however, he describes God's message as a fire burning him unless he speaks and highlights God's protection for him. Council members may also feel the burden of leadership but must still follow God's calling and rely on God. Council then prayed for members of the congregation in our prayer bowl time.

Council reviewed the tasks to be completed by Council and Admin when members are added to or withdraw from our congregation. Following this process, Council accepted the request of Kennedie H to transfer to another church. Council also reviewed the resignation letter from Marco D and appreciates the work she did for Council and the congregation.

In response to a request from the deacons, Council has decided to return to the process of passing the offering bags. Giving is part of our worship to God, so it is fitting to include that activity during our worship service together.

In preparation for considering nominations for elders and deacons, Council reviewed background information on both offices, including biblical qualifications and typical duties. Council thanks the congregation for the nomination suggestions. The nominees approved by Council will be invited to an information evening in May, and names will be presented to the congregation in early June.

Our next congregational meeting will be in mid June. The agenda will include a financial update. In addition, Council formed a sub-committee to look at the pros and cons of hiring a second ministry staff person or pastor. This committee will also present initial information at the meeting.

In the next steps of interacting with the Human Sexuality Report and related issues, Council is considering a video/discussion series on sexuality prepared by Classis.

Finally, Council would like to thank both Brendan B and Birgit M for their faithful service as deacons. Brendan extended his term by almost a year to ensure continuity within the diaconate, and the transition is now complete. Birgit recently stepped down from her position as deacon, where she graciously enfolded those in need with compassion and understanding. Thank you both for your time and commitment to our church council.
